The meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. Following the Call to Order, the public has the opportunity to comment on posted agenda items during the second section called Public Comments on Agenda Items. The sixth section is called Supervisor Requests. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the District's needs. The final section is called Audience Questions, Comments and Discussion Forum. This portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted.

Pursuant to provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations to participate in this meeting is asked to advise the District Office at (813) 873-7300, at least 48 hours before the meeting.
